HISTORY

The property at 160 Kings Rd was previously presented for construction of a new residence with associated landscape and hardscape in 2005. There have been minor revisions to the property since it's construction.

- New Front Door.
- Window infill on existing garage.
- Modification to vehicular gates and landscape.
- Installation of new generator.

STAFF ANALYSIS
