- a. Medjool Date Palm is not being replaced because the soil surrounding it is contaminated with Ganoderma. If we plant a new palm, it would most likely also become infected with Ganoderma.
 - Previously Approved Landscape buffer, including 22 Traveler Palms, is more than enough to sufficiently screen the neighboring property.
 - Traveler palms are not affected by Ganoderma.
 - The owner has done everything possible to try to save the palm, which is why we did not propose to remove in previous ARCOM submittal.
 - keeping a diseased palm and/or planting a new palm in diseased soil, can be dangerous considering the storms we experience in South Florida.
