STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Town Council approve Resolution No. 168-2024, approving an award to Envirosight for Sewer Inspection Camera in the amount of \$138,202.19, approving a contingency in the amount of \$6,900 for a total approved award in the amount of \$145,102.19.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION/BACKGROUND

The existing Aries Camera for Sewer Inspection, purchased in 2013 has come to the end of its useful life cycle. The camera is used to televise sewer laterals. The existing camera has been out of service for numerous repairs over the past several years.

Public Works submitted to replace the unit in the 2025 budget which was approved.

The new camera is being secured from the Sourcewell Cooperative Contract which provides the Town with substantial savings.

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for this unit will be from the Equipment Replacement Fund.
