The following scope of work is proposed:






STAFF ANALYSIS

A preliminary review of the project indicates that the proposed application complies with the Town's zoning code. The proposal includes the construction of a 6-foot site wall along the east property line, as well as portions of the northwest and northeast corners. The wall will feature cast stone with decorative stucco column caps. The project also preserves much of the existing vegetation, with plans to install additional landscaping, including silver buttonwood and green island ficus, along the new site wall.
