# **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends ratification of the property known as 138 Root Trail as a Town landmark.

## LANDMARKS PRESERVATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION

At the Public Hearing for Designation held during the January 17, 2018 meeting of the Landmarks Preservation Commission, the Commission voted (7-0) to recommend to the Town Council that the above mentioned property be designated as a landmark. In accordance with Section 54-164 (a) (11) of Chapter 54 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances, the Town Council shall hold a public hearing within ninety (90) days of the final decision of the Landmarks Commission to consider ratification of the Commission's recommendation.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The property meets the following criteria for designation as a landmark of the Town of Palm Beach:

Sec. 54-161 (1) Exemplifies or reflects the broad cultural, political, economic or social history of the nation, state, county or town.

Sec. 54-161 (3) Embodies distinguishing characteristics of an architectural type or a specimen inherently valuable for the study of a period, style, method of construction or use of indigenous materials or craftsmanship.

## **OWNER CONSENT**

The property owner, Sadeca Realty, was properly notified of the hearing before the Landmarks Preservation Commission. No person attended for the owner, nor were any comments received from the owner.
