

## RESOLUTION NO. 16-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION AND/OR THE DE-DESIGNATION OF THE HISTORIC/SPECIMEN TREES AT 300 EL BRILLO, 1255 AND 1265 SOUTH OCEAN BOULEVARD AND BRADLEY PARK, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The strangler fig (botanical name: Ficus Aurea) designated as a historic or specimen tree shall be removed from 300 El Brillo Way and the haden mango tree (botanical name: Mangifera Indica) shall be added as a historic or specimen tree with the Palm Beach County Clerk:

### **300 El Brillo Way (PCN/ Legal: 50-43-43-27-07-000-0010)**

Section 2. The water chestnut (botanical name: Pachira Aquatica ) designated as a historic or specimen tree shall be removed from 1255 South Ocean Boulevard and the silk floss tree (botanical name: Chorisia Speciosa) shall be added as a historic or specimen tree with the Palm Beach County Clerk:

### **1255 South Ocean Blvd (PCN/Legal: 50-43-44-02-10-000-007)**

Section 3. The ice cream bean (botanical name: Inga Inicuil), the black calabash (botanical name: Amphitecna Latifolia), the monkey flower (botanical name: Phyllocarpus Septentrionalis), the tropical crepe myrtle (botanical name: Lagerstromia Floribunda), and the elephant apple (botanical name: Dillenia Indica) designated as historic or specimen trees shall be removed from 20 Blossom Way:

### **20 Blossom Way (PCN/Legal: 50-43-44-02-10-000-0040)**

Section 4. The Spring Orchid (botanical name: Bauhinia Variegata) and Rose of Venezuela (botanical name: Brownea Grandiceps) designated as a historic or specimen tree shall be removed from 10 Blossom Way:

Section 5. The Burford Holly (botanical name: Ilex Cornutta Burfordii) designated as a historic or specimen tree shall be removed from 50 Blossom Way:

Section 6. The trees described in Sections 3, 4 and 5 shall be added as historic or specimen trees at 1265 South Ocean Boulevard and recorded with the Palm Beach County Clerk.

Section 7. The red cassia tree (botanical name: Cassia Afrofistula) located at 1265 South Ocean Blvd. shall be removed and relocated to a new location on the property.

Section 8. The sea grape tree (botanical name:Cocoloba Uvifera) and the black Olive tree (botanical name: Bucida Buceras) shall be added as historic or specimen trees at Bradley Park and recorded with the Palm Beach County Clerk.
