I have resided at 136 Seaview for 14 years & treasure our permit parking and the peaceful evenings & nights - those are two of the main reasons that I chose this address.

The thought of having a "club" atmosphere so nearby is very disturbing to me and to literally ALL of the neighbors who would also be adversely affected. It doesn't seem right that a commercial enterprise: club, bar, with late night hours, is even being considered !

Another location should be located - one which would not diminish all of the things that we cherish on our streets ... needless to say, Seaview would be very adversely affected: late night patrons would want to park as close to the club as possible; the valets would be zooming down our street, and the late night noise would be disturbing! The suggestion of "open parking" and/ or removing our permit parking is VERY unfair - we ALL chose the "100" blocks for obvious reasons.

None of us wants the status quo to change...

PLEASE DO NOT APPROVE THIS CLUB !

Why should the proposed "club" take precedent over the interest and well-being of all affected neighbors ? ? ?

As far as our existing permit parking, PLEASE do not take our privilege away for many reasons: safety considerations first & foremost. Most of our houses on the "Sea" streets are quite close to the roads. As it stands, we have quiet nights with no loiterers, loud voices or cars racing down the streets.
