Such a venue would completely and irrevocably change the character of the historic Phipps Plaza residential and small business community, surrounding businesses, restaurants and peaceful residential neighborhoods.

From what I have gleaned from the zoning codes, this project does not meet a number of requirements - it doesn't have ample parking; it grossly exceeds the square footage of the original restaurant space, resulting in high density occupancy; it's proposed hours of operation will disrupt daily (and nightly) life of the town's residents and quiet neighborhoods adjacent to it.
