STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Town Council accept the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for fiscal year ended September 30, 2017.

GENERAL INFORMATION

A copy of the Town of Palm Beach Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) for fiscal year ended September 30, 2017, completed in accordance with Section 11.45 of the Florida Statutes, is being provided to each of you under separate cover and can be viewed on the Town's website at www.townofpalmbeach.com under the "Government" tab, by clicking on Departments/Finance Department/Financial Reports.

This document serves as the required annual audit of the Town of Palm Beach. It exceeds the minimum requirements for an annual audit, providing information which staff expects will qualify the Town to receive the Government Finance Officers' Association Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting for the 30th consecutive year.

The completed CAFR will be forwarded to the Auditor General's Office once it is approved, to satisfy the statutory requirements.

The final reported General Fund unassigned fund balance for fiscal year ended September 30, 2017, is \$17,716,419. This amount represents 26.76% of the FY18 operating expenditure budget (total budget less CIP, coastal transfer and extraordinary retirement transfer), and exceeds the 25% minimum by \$1,165,947.
