STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Mayor and Town Council approve the purchase of two (2) police motorcycles in the amount of \$47,970 (\$23,985 each) from Bruce Rossmeyer's Daytona Harley Davidson. These items are included in the Town's Equipment Replacement Program and staff request funding from FY18 Equipment Replacement contingency allocation.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Police Department currently has six (6) Harley Davidson Motorcycles; two (2) are 2013 models, two (2) are 2012 models and two (2) are 2006 models. The Department motorcycles were on a 5 year useful life cycle but purchasing newer models was delayed until deemed necessary to do so based upon department operations and equipment safety. The two (2) 2006 models are no longer deemed safe for active police duty and will be sold at auction by the Purchasing Department upon disposition.

The new motorcycles will be purchased through the Florida Sheriffs Association State Bid #FSA17-VEL25.0 (Exhibit A) and quote dated February 15, 2018 received from Bruce Rossmeyer's Harley Davidson Police Sales (Exhibit B).

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

Sufficient funds have been designated in the Town's Equipment Replacement Program for the purchase of police motorcycles. However, funds were not included in the FY2018 Equipment Replacement budget request. Therefore, we are requesting \$47,970 from the FY2018 Equipment Replacement Contingency be approved for this purchase.
