STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff is requesting permission from Town Council to approve the Public Works Committee recommendation to install a stop bar, stop sign and/or signs designating “No Motorized Vehicles Allowed” at the Lake Trail access point between Reef Road and Esplanade Way on North Lake Way on a trial basis.

GENERAL INFORMATION

At the April 2, 2018 Town Council meeting, members discussed safety along the Lake Trail. Town Council agreed that staff needs to review the existing inventory of striping, delineators, and signs and then provide to the Public Works Committee for review.

Staff have reviewed lake trail access points and during the April 12, 2018 Public Works Committee meeting, a recommendation was made to have the Public Works department temporarily install necessary signage, and stop bars on the access between Reef Road and Esplanade Way on North Lake Way and monitor their effectiveness.

After the monitoring period, staff will bring back to the Public Works Committee their findings and provide further recommendations for additional lake trail access points.

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

Sufficient funds are available in the Public Works budget to complete this work.
