STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Mayor and Town Council approve Resolution No. 106-2018, authorizing the execution of the Security Agreement between the School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida and the Palm Beach Police Department and Town of Palm Beach.

GENERAL INFORMATION

As authorized by the Palm Beach County Law Enforcement Agencies Combined Operational Assistance and Voluntary Cooperation Mutual Aid Agreement ("Mutual Aid Agreement") entered into in 2016, it is requested and recommended that the Palm Beach Police Department and Town of Palm Beach enter into this Security Agreement which establishes that the Town of Palm Beach will provide Palm Beach police officers on non-charter public school campuses.

Municipal police officers, acting under this Security Agreement, shall have the same powers and authority as school safety officers and the Palm Beach Police Department shall be responsible for providing security services to the Palm Beach Public School as designated in said agreement.

Services provided by the Palm Beach Police Department will be treated as Special Detail assignments outside the normal duties/schedule of officers.

FUNDING IMPACT

The Town of Palm Beach will be compensated for said security services at the rate of \$70.00 per hour, per officer, as shown in Exhibit A of the Security Agreement. The School Board of Palm Beach County will be invoiced on a bi-weekly basis by the Palm Beach Police Department.

TOWN ATTORNEY REVIEW

The resolution and agreement have been reviewed and approved by the Town Attorney for legal form and sufficiency.
