STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends that Town Council approve Resolution No. 112-2018 granting a nonexclusive utility easement to Florida Power & Light (FPL), upon Town owned land within Palm Beach Estates Lots 120, 121, 124, 125, and 126 Palm Beach, Florida as recorded in Plat Book 8, Page 3 Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Existing lighting within the Phipps Ocean Park are fed by a combination of overhead and underground service lines. As part of the Town-wide Underground Phase-1 South, the lighting within Phipps Ocean Park parking lots will be replaced with the FPL LT-1 tariff lights and those overhead service lines will be undergrounded. FPL requires an easement for their conduit, electrical wires and other equipment necessary to provide lighting within Phipps Ocean Park. The proposed non-exclusive easement to accommodate conduit/wires is described in the attached sketch and legal description. The sketch and legal description of the proposed easement is provided by Dennis J. Leavy & Associates, Inc.
