

Request for Road Closure Letter

Worth Ave. from Hibiscus Ave to Gulfview Rd.

To whom it may concern: Worth Ave Association, Residences and Businesses

This letter is to inform all businesses and residences in the required area that Allegiance Crane & Equipment will be attending the Town Council meeting on 8/15/18 to request permission to place a crane in the right of way in front of 300 Worth Ave, Palm Beach. We are replacing the A/C units on the roof top of the Ralph Lauren clothing store. The request will be for a full closure of Worth Ave from Hibiscus Ave to Gulfview Rd, including the sidewalk on the south side of Worth Ave in front of Ralph Lauren. The sidewalks on the north side of Worth Ave and away from the Ralph Lauren store front will remain open.

Worth Ave from South County Road to Hibiscus will not be affected. All shops from Hibiscus Avenue to Gulfview Road can remain open as they will be accessible to foot traffic. Gulfview Road to Coconut Row will be opened to two way-way traffic with off-duty officers and traffic channeling devices.

The job will take up to 8 hours to complete. We need 2 hours to assemble the crane, 4 hours to replace the A/C units and 2 hours to dismantle the crane. Once the job is complete the street and sidewalk will be reopened.

Daytime hours would be 8am till 4pm. If done overnight the starting time would be 8pm and all work would be finished no later than 4am the following morning. The proposed work date would be the week of the August 20th.
