LANDMARKS PRESERVATION COMMISSION

(LPC) - The LPC safeguards the Town's historic and cultural resources through its landmarked structures and historic districts. This State of Florida Certified Commission reviews and approves structural and landscape modifications to Designated structures and properties. The LPC is comprised of seven regular and three alternate members, who are registered voters of the Town of Palm Beach and appointed by the Town Council, and who have, to the highest extent practicable, a special knowledge of and a known interest in landmarks preservation. One commissioner may be a non-resident of the Town who possesses specific knowledge or skills directly related to the preservation of historic structures or property. At least two members, but not more than three members, shall be registered architects in the State of Florida. In the event that there are, in the discretion of the Town Council, no bona fide applicants who are registered architects in the State of Florida, the Town may solicit and appoint architects registered outside the State of Florida to fill one of the architect seats. Members are appointed for three-year terms and no member may serve more than two consecutive terms, although a member may be eligible for reappointment upon the lapse of nine months after the expiration of the member's second consecutive three-year term. Although an alternate member may not serve more than two three-year terms as an alternate, an alternate member may be appointed to serve as a regular member of the commission and, in the event of such appointment, shall be entitled to serve two full three-years terms thereafter.

Landmarks Preservation Commission Application of Marcia Mulford Cini

1. I am interested in serving on the Palm Beach Landmarks Preservation Commission because I have always been involved in civic life, I have the appropriate background and qualifications, and my ancestors were prominent in Palm Beach in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Joseph Mulford, who with his wife Mary Cluett Mulford, came here from upstate New York in the 1880s, founded Bethesda-by-the-Sea Episcopal Church, the third incarnation of which currently stands today on Barton Avenue and South County Road. We are active members in this church, having renewed our vows with Fr. James Harlan on the occasion of our 50th wedding anniversary in Palm Beach in 2013, the year we moved here. I am also at a juncture in my life, having closed my law practice and officially retired at the end of last month (December 2017), where it seems to make sense to give back to the community with my talents.

3. I have served on the Board of Directors and Chairman of the Governance Committee of the Martha's Vineyard Museum for six years (term limits require that I take this year off) during a 24 m. dollar capital campaign, historic rehabilitation and museum move. I am currently on the Board of Island Elderly Housing, Inc. (20 years) and Havenside Corporation (4 years), both on Martha's Vineyard. Vice Chairman of the Dukes County Bar Association, I was elected island-wide to two terms of two years each on the Martha's Vineyard Commission, at which time I was lured but did not succumb to the opportunities represented by election to the state legislature. I also served on the West Tisbury Historic District Commission and was Chairman of the Topsfield Historic District Commission for approximately ten years each. I was also appointed to the Tisbury Community Preservation Committee, a state statutorily mandated program, at its origination and served again for ten years (until last summer). In each instance, it would have never occurred to me to miss a meeting, so my attendance record was essentially perfect.

5. and 6. A word of explanation: In New England, designated historic properties are what Palm Beach calls "landmarked" properties. My immediate family and I have owned two, one in Jericho Center, Vermont (1814) and one in Topsfield, Massachusetts (1756). We made our home in each of these and in all respects treated them historically appropriately, including making them available for house tours.

11. My educational background suits me perfectly for this appointment. My undergraduate degree is a B. A. in history from American University in Washington, DC. Instead of pursuing Education at Columbia University in NYC, I got an M.A. in Preservation Studies from Boston University, where I specialized in adaptive reuse and twentieth century resources. After I went to B.U. Law School, earned a J.D. (Juris Doctor) degree, passed the bar exam and practiced law in Massachusetts for approximately 25 years.

12. My educational background and experience as well as how I have spent my time during my entire adult life qualify me for an appointment to the Palm Beach Landmarks Preservation Commission. In addition to pursuing a preservation career, which I did up until I went to law school in search of a more lucrative way to make a living and having served as a full time preservation consultant under the aegis of my own company, Associated Preservation Services, Inc., I

volunteered for two commissions similar to the Landmarks Preservation Commission in that they were promoters of and arbiters of alterations to historic structures. I also served on numerous civic or non-profit organization boards, always identified with the protection of historic interests. During my law practice I submitted plenty of federal tax credit applications, worked on some very large projects that included state and federal tax credits, and am currently listed on the Massachusetts Historical Commission's list of recommended historic preservation consultants. I still get phone calls about my master's degree thesis on the Kirkbride complex at Danvers State Hospital, which formed the basis for a National Register of Historic Places nomination and listing for it and more than one book and art exhibit. I truly believe not only in a "city's right to be beautiful" (Berman v. Parker) but the more you know about how we got to be the way we are, the better decisions we can make for the future.

The following is supplemental information to my Landmarks Preservation Commission Application Form.

1. Why I am interested in serving on LPC.

I am interested in architecture, history and preservation and I grew up outside of Philadelphia, a city steeped in all three. My mother had grown up in Charleston, South Carolina and she encouraged an appreciation of architecture. Our Palm Beach community is filled with beautiful houses and buildings. I really enjoyed being on the Landmarks Commission before and would like to be a commission member again and apply my talents and experience to continue to help preserve our architectural legacy for the future.

6. My experience in dealing with landmarked properties.

While a member of the Landmarks Preservation Commission from 1989—1996, with Jane Volk as the Chair many of these years. I participated actively in the efforts to landmark many important properties, including the following:

8 South Lake Trail (Landmarked in 1990)

This Ballinger award winning property of nearly two acres is located in the center of the oldest residential district in Palm Beach, at the lakefront end of Clarke Avenue. The spectacular John Volk house and expansive formal gardens with giant kapok tree are among the great treasures of our Town.

Palm Beach Day School (later Palm Beach Day Academy) (Landmarked in 1991)

LANDMARKS PRESERVATION COMMISSION

(LPC) - The LPC safeguards the Town's historic and cultural resources through its landmarked structures and historic districts. This State of Florida Certified Commission reviews and approves structural and landscape modifications to Designated structures and properties. The LPC is comprised of seven regular and three alternate members, who are registered voters of the Town of Palm Beach and appointed by the Town Council, and who have, to the highest extent practicable, a special knowledge of and a known interest in landmarks preservation. One commissioner may be a non-resident of the Town who possesses specific knowledge or skills directly related to the preservation of historic structures or property. At least two members, but not more than three members, shall be registered architects in the State of Florida. In the event that there are, in the discretion of the Town Council, no bona fide applicants who are registered architects in the State of Florida, the Town may solicit and appoint architects registered outside the State of Florida to fill one of the architect seats. Members are appointed for three-year terms and no member may serve more than two consecutive terms, although a member may be eligible for reappointment upon the lapse of nine months after the expiration of the member's second consecutive three-year term. Although an alternate member may not serve more than two three-year terms as an alternate, an alternate member may be appointed to serve as a regular member of the commission and, in the event of such appointment, shall be entitled to serve two full three-years terms thereafter.
