STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The Office of Information Technology is recommending the renewal of the annual software support for the Town's AIMS software in the amount of \$37,500.00. This renewal provides all of the Town's licensing, support and maintenance for the AIMS system. Staff is recommending the adoption of Resolution No. 138-2018, which authorizes the Town Manager to approve the issuance of a purchase order for this renewal and expend the funds from the FY2019 budget once it is approved.

GENERAL INFORMATION

On an annual basis, the Office of Information Technology has to renew the software licensing, support and maintenance for AIMS Ticketing and Permit system that is used by the Town.

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

This purchase will come from the Information Technology General Fund Software Maintenance account and is included in the FY2019 budget.
