STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Town Council approve Resolution No. 187-2018 authorizing the Town of Palm Beach, ex post facto, to submit FY2018 Presidential Residence Protection Assistance (PRPA) grant application for reimbursement of qualifying law enforcement personnel overtime for the protection of the President and family while in residence in the Town Palm Beach.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This grant program is administered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) under the Department of Homeland Security Appropriations Act, 2018, (Pub. L. No. 115-141) and provides for the reimbursement of overtime activities associated with the protection of any non-governmental residence of the President designated or identified to be secured by the United States Secret Service (USSS). Awards are made on a rolling basis to qualifying agencies, therefore, so as to not jeopardize this grant reimbursement opportunity, the application was submitted prior to the November 15, 2018 deadline.

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

FEMA anticipates that all awards will be made no later than December 31, 2018. The Town anticipates a minimum reimbursement of \$37,454.97 for overtime expenses incurred while the President was in residence during the application period of October 1, 2017 – September 30, 2018. However, there is the possibility of reimbursement up to \$57,613.22 for other applicable overtime (President not in residence) depending on funding availability.
