- 1) Continue to examine the budget to identify opportunities to restructure Town operations by increasing revenue and reducing expenditures, while maintaining an extraordinary level of service and focusing on working more efficiently.
- 2) Work with the Retirement Board to identify ways to address the Town's unfunded pension liability.
- 3) Complete and analyze the results of the compensation and benefits study by Evergreen Solution, LLC and take steps to resolve attrition and recruitment amongst the Town's Public Safety and General Employees.
- 4) Find innovative solutions to address the rising construction costs of the undergrounding project. Wisely apply the lessons learned in Phase 1 to address unforeseen expenses and issues, improve the process for the residents, including enhancing communication with residents on project timelines and transformer locations.
- 5) Complete the Town Docks project on time and on budget and identify ways to increase revenue through the renovation, rebuilding and enhancement of the Town Docks. Provide monthly updates to Public Works committee and Council on critical path, key decisions, and budget performance.
- 6) Analyze and utilize the results of the coastal integrity study being performed by Woods Hole Group to set priorities for the actions the Town can take to protect and armor its ocean and inlet shorelines from flooding due to storms, king tides and sea level rise. Based on these priorities, review potential costs and budget mechanisms.
