PROPOSED PUBLIC SAFETY MEETING AGENDA Thursday, January 30, 2018

1. COUNCIL UPDATE on Compensation Study. Where we are, where we are heading. Synopsis of Mayor and Council meetings with Police and Firefighter/ Medics.

2.POLICE UPDATE: Crime statistics by type; clearance rate; year over year comparison of statistics; purpose of new training equipment provided by The Police Foundation- VIRTRA SIMULATOR; Manpower/Staffing report: number of positions, turnover/attrition of officers, new appointments and promotions; Introduction (Resurrection) of Joint Police & Fire Citizen's Academy; goal for 2019: increase community policing: bicycles, ATV's – beach patrol, more foot patrol, aka "walk and talk", in addition to vehicle patrol.

3. FIREFIGHTER/MEDIC UPDATE: Fire and Medical call statistics by type and response times; year over year comparison of statistics; presentation of new fire rescue equipment including a demonstration of ultrasound and its application; Manpower/ staffing report: turnover/attrition of firefighters; new appointments and promotions; overview of 2019 community programs: Prescription Medication Review, Fall Prevention, Hurricane Preparedness.

4. Recognition of Outstanding Citizens: those who have helped solve or prevent crimes, The Police Foundation: Palm Beach Civic Association.

5. TRAFFIC SAFETY ISSUES: Discussion of safety concerns pertaining to 2 or more bicycles riding abreast on the roadway and review of applicable current laws/code; discussion of hedge heights and vehicle visibility issues.

6. BIKE TRAIL ISSUES: increased use of trail; enforcement for speeding (speed is 10 mph) and failing to yield to pedestrians and use of an audible alarm; cameras under bridge (incident in WPB); consider motorized scooter ordinance.
