STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Town Council receive a report from the valet operator regarding the Worth Avenue Valet Parking Pilot Program's (200 Block) performance data and other information discovered during the implementation of the program.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Town Council approved the Worth Avenue Valet Pilot Parking Program on December 12, 2018, subject to a condition that the valet operator return on a monthly basis to report performance data and other information discovered during implementation of the program to the Town Council at the regularly scheduled meetings.

The Valet Parking Pilot Program seeks to address the traffic congestion on Worth Avenue and the lack of available parking spaces. The program includes two valet stations along the south side of the 200 block of Worth Avenue from 10 A.M. to 6 P.M., Monday through Saturday, which began operation in December 2018, and will end on Saturday, April 27, 2019.
