Attached, please find an updated version of the Carriage House Declaration of Use. Skip made a revision to #27 of the attached so that this section now reads as follows:

"The Club may use Phipps Plaza Park for Club purposes, however, any event within the Park which uses Club services shall be considered a Club event, regardless of the number of participants, and shall be bound to the time constraints and the number of events allowed as stated in paragraph 14. Further, prior to any such event taking place, the Club shall apply to the Town Council for authority to use Phipps Plaza Park for a Club related event with notice to the public being given at least ninety (90) days prior to said event."
