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## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that Town Council approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 13-2019, amending Chapter 134, Article X – On-Street Parking Permits, of the Town Code of Ordinances.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Chapter 134, Article X of the Town Code of Ordinances outlines how the Town must administer the residential permit parking program for on-street parking spaces, including the issuance of permit decals and visitor passes. The Code currently restricts the number of visitor pass to two (2) per property, in addition to the two (2) decals properties are also entitled to.

Over the years staff has received suggestions from time to time to create more flexibility for residents in how we administer the issuance of permits. Most recently, I received multiple requests from residents in the Sea streets to not limit the number of visitor passes to two, but instead allow for the flexibility to purchase one (1) decal and three (3) visitor passes for example. Staff feels that this is a very reasonable and resident friendly request, hence the recommendation to modify the code to create this flexibility. Simply put, the attached Ordinance No. 13-2019 will provide residents in RPP areas the flexibility to purchase up to four (4) permits in whatever form (decal and/or visitor pass) they deem most beneficial to their needs.
