STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Town Council consider adopting Ordinances 12-2019 & 14-2019 at their Second Reading.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Staff has determined the best way to create this requirement on owners and builders is through the adoption of two ordinances. One to add language to the Architectural; Review Commission requirements in Chapter 18 and the other one to add language to Landmarks Preservation Commission in Chapter 54. The language in both ordinances is similar but does distinguish between the rolls each commission plays in reviewing and regulating construction. Both ordinances allow the use of existing landscape buffering. Both ordinances allow the mix of walls, landscape, and screening fences and gates to secure the perimeters of properties and screen the construction project from neighbor properties and the public right of ways.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The two ordinances have been reviewed by the Town Attorney for legal form and sufficiency. Both ordinances were approved at their First Reading on March 19, 2019. Ordinances No. 12-2019 (Chapter 18) and 14-2019 (Chapter 54) are ready to be adopted on Second Reading.
