STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends that Town Council approve the second reading of Ordinance 22-2019 amending Chapter 102 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Collection of residential and commercial solid waste is unique in location and procedures all through Town. Accessibility, appearance, and function for both residential and commercial establishments are a few of the factors that play a role when determining the correct collection locations.

In Chapter 102, Sec.102-5 the Ordinance provides information regarding placement for disposal that must be authorized but does not provide information to identify the person authorizing the appropriate location. Additionally, information is not provided identifying procedures if garbage is placed in an unauthorized place.

Staff recommends the following revisions notated by strikethrough and underlines to this section of the ordinance.

Sec. 102-5. - Deposit in unauthorized place.

No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any refuse in any place <u>not unauthorized</u> for disposal. The Public Works Director or their designee shall determine the authorized location for collection and disposal. Garbage placed for collection in an unauthorized place will not be collected and procedures set forth in section(s) 102-48 and 102-7 will be administered.
