

RESOLUTION NO. 44-2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A PROJECT PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH AND THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS FOR INITIAL PROJECT CONSTRUCTION AND CONTINUED RENOURISHMENTS OF THE PALM BEACH COUNTY FEDERAL SHORE PROTECTION PROJECT, MID-TOWN SEGMENT.

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WHEREAS, the U.S. Congress passed a Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018, Public Law 115-123 for Long-term Disaster Recovery; and

WHEREAS, the Mid-Town Segment for the Palm Beach County Federal Shore Protection Project was included in the list of Long-term Disaster Recovery projects to be completed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Palm Beach (Town) and the USACE have worked cooperatively by executing memoranda of understanding and cost-sharing agreements related to implementing the Town's Comprehensive Coastal Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the USACE has developed a Project Partnership Agreement for cost-share on eligible project elements and implementation of the Palm Beach County Federal Shore Protection Project, Mid-Town Segment.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 2. The Town Council hereby authorizes a Project Partnership Agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for the Palm Beach County Federal Shore Protection Project, Mid-Town Segment.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Project Partnership Agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for the Palm Beach County Federal Shore Protection Project, Mid-Town Segment, on behalf of the Town.
