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## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Town staff recommends that Town Council approve Resolution No. 106-2019 authorizing the Mayor to sign the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Agreement 20PB5 for State cost sharing participation in the amount of \$28,470 for additional reimbursement of monitoring for the 2016 Phipps Ocean Park Beach Nourishment Project.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Each year the Town provides a Local Government Funding Request (LGFR) to the FDEP for projects that are eligible for State cost sharing. The LGFR includes specific project details that are each assigned scores. The scores are tallied and the projects are ranked in competition with other statewide requested projects. Florida Legislature determines the size of the annual appropriation that is assigned to projects on the ranked list. For the State's 2018/2019 fiscal year, the Phipps Ocean Park project ranked high enough to receive cost sharing (39%) for various monitoring tasks.

## **FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT**

State funds will reimburse the Town \$28,470 for eligible monitoring costs associated with the 2016 Phipps Ocean Park Beach Nourishment Project. State reimbursement funds are to be placed in the Town's Coastal Fund to either fund future coastal projects, or offset future account transfers.

## **TOWN ATTORNEY REVIEW**

This Resolution has been reviewed and approved by the Town Attorney for legal form and sufficiency. In addition, the Town's Attorney will review the FDEP contract and approve it for legal form and sufficiency prior to execution.
