STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Town Council approval of Resolution No. 119-2019, approving a Purchase Order to Duval Ford for two Police Interceptor Hybrid Vehicles to replace two current patrol vehicles that have exceeded useful life expectancy in the amount of \$101,479.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION/BACKGROUND

The Police Department identified two patrol vehicles for replacement due to age and associated cost to maintain on the road. Both vehicles are model year 2011 Chevy Caprices.

The Ford Police Interceptor Hybrid is being purchased from the Florida Sherriff Contract.

FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

Funding for this purchase is available in the approved FY2020 Equipment Replacement Fund.

DUE DILIGENCE
