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### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends Town Council approve Resolution No. 149-2019, Approving the Award of a Purchase Order to M&M Asphalt Maintenance, Inc. dba All County Paving for Phase 2 Resurfacing Project in the Amount of \$409,736.50 and Establishing a Project Budget of \$471,196.

### **SUMMARY EXPLANATION/BACKGROUND**

Town Purchasing piggybacked the Palm Beach School Board Contract for paving. The School Board awarded a Contract for Road Work and Pavement Markings, 17C-19T to M&M Asphalt, Inc. dba All County Paving.

The Contract with All County Paving has proven to be a great source for Town-wide paving needs, offering excellent work and best pricing. Both the School Board and the vendor have agreed to extend the contract options to the Town.

The spreadsheets contained within the Proposal detail nearly 29,370 SY of milling of existing asphalt pavement including disposal and type III pavement resurfacing, for Phase 2 North, in addition to 725 SY of milling and resurfacing for Via Manana.

### **FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE**

The funding will for this program is from Pay-to-Go and a contribution of forty percent from the Florida Public Utility.

### **USER DEPARTMENT CONCURRENCE**

Public Works is in full concurrence with this recommendation.

## **DUE DILIGENCE**

Due Diligence was conducted to determine vendor responsibility, including corporate status and that there are no performance and compliance issues. The review included conducting market research. The vendor has completed work within the Town with a high degree of success.
