STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends approval of Resolution No. 154-2019 to authorize a Construction Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for work associated with the project that is located within the FDOT right-of-way.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Town staff and the project consultant for this project (Baird and Associates) have been working with the FDOT staff and the Town Attorney to review and edit the proposed Construction Agreement. Minor modifications to the standard agreement have been included at Section IV of Exhibit A.

Staff requests that the Town Council approve Resolution No. 154-2019 to enter into a Construction Agreement with FDOT, which is required because the northern portion of the bulkhead is to be tied into the bridge abutment to provide a continuous seawall at the proper elevation. That work located within the FDOT right-of-way requires execution of a Construction Agreement between the Town and FDOT to authorize that work.
