STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that Town Council approve Resolution No. 145-2019, approving and adopting the revised 2020 Palm Beach County Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) Plan.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The approval and adoption of Resolution No. 145-2019 is required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the Town to be in compliance with federal guidelines introduced in response to the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000. As described in the LMS Plan, adoption of the plan is required in order for Palm Beach County and participating municipalities, including the Town of Palm Beach, to be eligible to apply for and receive pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes.

It is important to note it was through the LMS process that the Town applied for and ultimately received nearly \$8.5 million in HMGP grant funding for the Town-wide undergrounding project. We were eligible to apply because we were in full compliance with the requirements of participation in the County's LMS program.
