Dear Mayor, Members of the Town Council, and Deputy Town Manager,

It has come to our attention that garbage pickup from the Palm Beach Hotel is picked up almost daily, on Park Avenue, and not in front of their hotel. We are new residents of Park Avenue, and are appalled that we must endure not only the smell of many garbage containers, but the unsightly view of these containers. The prolific noise of the garbage truck, barrels being bounced back onto the sidewalk for at least twenty minutes daily, has left Park Avenue an unsightly afterthought. We pay the same amount of taxes as everyone on the island, and this practice of using Park Avenue as their personal dumping ground needs to be revisited with a responsible solution.

The hotel clearly knows not only is their garbage an eyesore, but they don't want their hotel guests enduring, what we, on Park Avenue must endure. We are the year round residents, and not the hotel guests. If you look at any of the hotels on the island, they take responsibility for their garbage pickup, without the audacity of palming it off on someone else's front yard.
