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## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Town Council consider the applicant's request to modify the approved hours of operation for La Goulue Restaurant located at 288 South County Road.

## **BACKGROUND**

On April 10, 2019, the Town Council conditionally approved zoning petition Z-19-00176, which requested special exception and site plan approval for a new restaurant called La Goulue to be located in the space formerly occupied by Chez L'Epicier, 288 South County Road, Palm Beach. The Town Council approved the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., seven days a week, with brunch on Saturday and Sunday starting at 10:30 a.m. with occasional special events.

The applicant is requesting that the Town Council amend the previously approved hours to allow the operation from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., seven days a week, with brunch on Saturday and Sunday starting at 10:30 a.m., together with occasional special events (see attached letter from James Crowley).
