STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends that the Town Council approve Resolution No. 20-2020 for a required Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) for the improvements in the FDOT right-of-way associated with the Town Marina Project.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Town Council had previously approved at their December 10, 2019 meeting a Construction Agreement with FDOT for the scope of work that occurs within their right-of-way. A corresponding MMOA was prepared by FDOT to define the maintenance responsibilities and is attached for approval. Upon Town Council approval, the MMOA will be executed by the Town Manager (or his designee) and FDOT.

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

No additional funding is required to implement this agreement. Construction of the bulkhead/seawall is already included in construction budget. Future maintenance of these improvements in FDOT's right-of-way should be minimal.

TOWN ATTORNEY REVIEW

The Town Attorney has reviewed the proposed agreement for legal form and sufficiency.
