STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends that Town Council approve Resolution No. 16-2020 granting a non-exclusive utility easement to Florida Power & Light (FPL), upon Town owned land within ALTO LIDO lots 21 Palm Beach, Florida as recorded in Plat Book 11, Page 36 Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The owner at 226 Kenlyn Road has requested to relocate the transformer from their property to directly across the street to the Town owned property, Palmo Park. They have agreed to pay all associated costs to relocate the transformer, conduit, and wiring. The transformer will not be the only piece of equipment in Palmo Park. Staff presented, with Town Council, approved easements within Palmo Park for the May 2019 Town Council for two (2) switch cabinets and two (2) capacitor banks on Plamo Way. The proposed non-exclusive easement is to accommodate equipment and conduit/wires as described in the attached sketch and legal description. The sketch and legal description of the proposed easement is provided by Avirom & Associates, Inc.
