### LANDMARKS PRESERVATION COMMISSION

(LPC) - The LPC safeguards the Town's historic and cultural resources through its landmarked structures and historic districts. This State of Florida Certified Commission reviews and approves structural and landscape modifications to Designated structures and properties. The LPC is comprised of seven regular and three alternate members, who are registered voters of the Town of Palm Beach and appointed by the Town Council, and who have, to the highest extent practicable, a special knowledge of and a known interest in landmarks preservation. One commissioner may be a non-resident of the Town who possesses specific knowledge or skills directly related to the preservation of historic structures or property. At least two members, but not more than three members, shall be registered architects in the State of Florida, the Town may solicit and appoint architects registered outside the State of Florida to fill one of the architect seats. Members are appointed for three-year terms and no member may serve more than two consecutive terms, although a member may be eligible for reappointment upon the lapse of nine months after the expiration of the member's second consecutive three-year term. Although an alternate member may not serve more than two three-year terms as an alternate, an alternate member may be appointed to serve as a regular member of the commission and, in the event of such appointment, shall be entitled to serve two full three-years terms thereafter.
