STAFF REQUEST & RECOMMENDATION

Staff requests that the Town Council consider Ordinance No. 09-2020 (revisions to Chapter 54, Historical Preservation). Staff further recommends that the Town Council approve Ordinance No. 09-2020 on First Reading.

GENERAL INFORMATION

During the March 11, 2020 Town Council Development Review meeting, a request to staff was made to draft an ordinance to limit the term of the "non-resident" member of the Landmarks Preservation Commission to the same term limits of the other commission members.

The ordinance has been reviewed by the Town Attorney for legal form and sufficiency.

Ordinance No. 09-2020 (Chapter 54) is ready at this time to be approved on First Reading.

Also attached is the simple text change required if the Town Council decided to change the Landmarks Preservation Commission to a five member board with two alternates. This was briefly discussed at last month's meeting. This simple change <u>is not</u> included in Ordinance No. 09-2020, but presented only for discussion purposes.
