As one of the first original owners at 129 Hammon Ave., Unit 2, since 2013, we've never have had any problems with noise from the Colony Hotel until recently.

Since the Colony has renovated and expanded to the east side of their property, we have had very loud and unpleasant noises and extremely loud music coming from there.

I usually receive notifications in the mail from the Town of Palm Beach regarding any changes or variances to properties around our building, but I do not remember receiving anything that mentioned the usage changes to the east side of their property that would allow them to make all those loud music, singing and dancing noises.

I strongly object to the new usage of their east side property, along with my other Ocean Colony neighbors.

Please bring my objections to the notice of the Palm Beach Town Board or whomever oversee's these types of changes of use or appeal the current use to change the use of this space.
