ORDINANCE NO. 15-2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING THE TOWN CODE OF ORDINANCES AT CHAPTER 74, <u>PARKS AND</u> <u>RECREATION, AT DIVISION 3, REGULATION OF USE OF PUBLIC</u> <u>BEACHES, SECTION 74-196, PRESENCE DURING CLOSED</u> HOURS; HOURS SPECIFIED TO MODIFY THE NAME LAKE WORTH TO LAKE WORTH BEACH AND TO ADD THE PUBLIC BEACH FROM WELLS ROAD SOUTH TO SUNSET AVENUE AS <u>AN ADDITIONAL BEACH DECLARED TO BE CLOSED TO THE</u> <u>PUBLIC EACH DAY FROM SUNSET TO SUNRISE OFFENSES;</u> <u>SECTION 74-196, "PRESENCE DURING CLOSED HOURS; HOURS</u> <u>SPECIFIED</u>; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Code of Ordinances of the Town of Palm Beach is hereby amended at Chapter 74, <u>Parks and Recreation</u>, <u>Division 3</u>, <u>Regulation of Use of Public Beaches amending</u>-Section 74-196, <u>Presence during Closed Hours</u>, to read as follows:

"Sec. 74-196. – Presence during closed hours; hours specified."

No person shall use or be upon any public beach in the Town during the hours when any such beach is declared to be closed to the public as hereinafter set forth:

- (1) Phipps Park is declared to be closed to the public each day from sunset to sunrise the following day.
- (2) The public beach from Royal Palm Way south to Gulfstream Road is declared to be closed to the public each day from sunset to sunrise.
- (3) The Clarke Avenue beach area is declared to be closed to the public each day from sunset to sunrise.
- (4) The public beach owned by the county lying north of the City of Lake Worth <u>Beach</u> casino property extending approximately 500 feet northerly therefrom is declared to be closed to the public each day form sunset to sunrise.
- (5) <u>The public beach from Wells Road south to Sunset Avenue is declared to be closed to the public each day from sunset to sunrise;</u> -

Section 2. Repeal of Ordinances in Conflict.

All other ordinances of the Town, of Palm Beach, Florida, or parts thereof which conflict with this or any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. Codification This Ordinance shall be codified and made a part of the official Code of Ordinances of the Town of Palm Beach.

<u>Section 4</u>. Effective Date. The Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, as provided by law.
