## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Town Staff recommends approval of Resolution Number 041-2021 for the purchase of a new Fire Rescue Ambulance in the amount of \$254,336 and establish a project budget of \$264,336.

## **WHY THIS ACTION IS REQUIRED NOW**

The existing Fire Rescue Ambulance has exceeded the useful life expectancy.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The new ambulance will replace a 2010 Freightliner Ambulance, asset# 101050, currently in service as Rescue 97 at Central Fire Station #1. The department has this budgeted to be replaced in FY21.

The new ambulance will be built on a 2022 Ford F450 chassis per the attached specifications in accordance with Florida Sheriff's Association bid #FSA20-VEF14.0.

## **PROCUREMENT METHODOLOGY**

Town Purchasing has accessed the Florida Sheriff's Association bid #FSA20-VEF14.0 which provides best pricing State wide.

## **FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT**

The new ambulance will be funded from the Equipment Replacement Fund.
