Resolution No. 058-2021 - Negotiated Savings of \$50,000

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends that Town Council approve Resolution No. 058-2021 approving a purchase order to Coastal Protection Engineering, LLC (CPE), in the amount of \$146,160 to complete the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Beach Management Agreement (BMA) required 2021 Palm Beach Island Cell-Wide Biological Monitoring, and establish a monitoring and reporting phase budget of \$156,000.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CPE is one of two firms that have professional services agreements from RFQ 2020-15. CPE and Coastal Eco-Group will be performing all of the State and Federal regulatory required biological monitoring to satisfy the obligations under the FDEP Beach Management Agreement and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers permits.

The CPE comprehensive scope of work, dated May 24, 2021, includes the BMA required tasks. These tasks include aerial delineation of hardbottom, nearshore environmental resources edge mapping, and both benthic and sedimentation data collection and analyses. Project-related monitoring will be performed by Coastal Eco-Group, Inc. The work and reporting by CPE will be done together with the additional biological monitoring by CEG.

Staff is working with FDEP staff to identify any potential State cost-sharing for this regionally beneficial work effort. The Town has been successful in previous years with obtaining State cost-sharing for annual required biological monitoring work.

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

The Coastal Protection Fund includes sufficient funds to accomplish the annual regulatory required scope of work as proposed by both CPE and Coastal Eco-Group, Inc.

PURCHASING REVIEW

This item has been reviewed by the Purchasing Division and approved as recommended.

TOWN ATTORNEY REVIEW
