I am following up on our conversation regarding the number of parking permits the town will issue to residents. Currently, as you are aware, up to eight parking permits may be purchased by homeowners. I would argue that this number is too high.

I feel it is inappropriate to issue more permits than there are spaces available for on any street and especially in the event where the number of permits issued to any one homeowner would mandate that the vehicles would need to park in front of other peoples' homes.

My concern stems from an issue we are experiencing here on Dunbar. As you are aware, to adjust to the recent parking restrictions on County Rd, we on Dunbar went to a permit parking street. This has alleviated a lot of the problem, but we do have at least one neighbor who parks eight vehicles on the street and one or two more who just seem to prefer street parking in lieu of parking on their property.

Dunbar was once a quiet and beautiful tree lined street with open vistas to the water on both the east and west. It now looks more like a commercial zone as very rarely is it free from parked cars during the evenings and weekends. It is my opinion that this reduces the beauty of our street and that feeling of charm that we once enjoyed. Unfortunately, although they are obeying the rules, it seems to be our own neighbors here who are the cause of the problem. Seeing this charm slowly slip away concerns me a great deal as we continue to evolve as a town.

I am not sure what an acceptable resolution would be, if any, but would appreciate if you would voice my concerns to the Town Council.
