## **RESOLUTION NO. 104-2021**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE GENERAL (OPERATING) FUND, DEBT SERVICE FUND, AND BUDGETS FOR OTHER FUNDS FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR.

WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires among other things that the Town Council of the Town of Palm Beach adopt the tentative General (Operating) Fund, Debt Service Fund Budgets, and budgets for other funds after notice and public hearing, prior to adopting final millage rates or final budgets; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has conducted a public hearing on the tentative General (Operating) Fund millage rate and budget as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH:

Section 1. The tentative General (Operating) Fund, Debt Service Fund Budgets, and Budgets for Other Funds for the Town of Palm Beach as attached, marked Exhibit A, are hereby adopted for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2021, and ending September 30, 2022.

Section 2. The tentative General (Operating) Fund, Debt Service Fund Budgets, and Budgets for Other Funds adopted by this resolution shall be subject to review and amendment by the Town Council of the Town of Palm Beach at a public hearing to be conducted at 5:01 P.M. on Thursday, September 23, 2021, in the Town Council Chambers, 360 South County Road, Palm Beach, Florida.
