STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends that Town Council approve Resolution No. 119-2021 authorizing the Mayor to sign the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Agreement 22PB12 for State cost sharing participation in the amount of \$324,500 for reimbursement of Lake Worth Inlet/Beach Management Agreement annual monitoring.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Each year the Town provides a Local Government Funding Request (LGFR) to the FDEP for projects that are eligible for State cost sharing. The LGFR includes specific project details that are each assigned scores. The scores are tallied and the projects are ranked in competition with other statewide requested projects. Florida Legislature determines the size of the annual appropriation that is assigned to projects on the ranked list. The Lake Worth Inlet Management Plan/Beach Management Agreement monitoring sufficiently scored on the ranked list to be included for reimbursement within the FY 2021-2022 approved State budget.

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

State funds will reimburse the Town \$324,500 for eligible costs associated with Lake Worth Inlet Management Plan/Beach Management Agreement annual monitoring. This reimbursement amount covers half of the total cost for the annual physical, biological, and sea turtle nesting monitoring for last year.

TOWN ATTORNEY REVIEW

This Resolution has been reviewed and approved by the Town Attorney for legal form and sufficiency. In addition, the Town's Attorney will review the FDEP contract and approve it for legal form and sufficiency prior to execution.
