STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Town Council adopt Ordinance No. 21-2021 on second reading, modifying beach access hours and including Root Trail as a public access location, and provide additional direction for implementation as necessary.

GENERAL INFORMATION

At the August 11, 2021, Town Council meeting, Ordinance No. 21-2021 (attached) was approved on first reading. At said meeting, staff was asked to provide information, relative to how beach access locations are currently managed, in terms of fencing and gates, and provide information regarding how staff intended on securing the Root Trail access point.

Contained within is information relating to the commitment from Ocean Towers to partner with the Town in securing their private portion of the Root Trail access point, along with the information requested by Council for the other beach access locations within the Town.
