## **RESOLUTION NO. 157-2021**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE DE-DESIGNATION AND DESIGNATION OF TREE NUMBER TWENTY-SIX (26) A CARACAS FIG AS HISTORIC AND SPECIMEN TREE AT 174 VIA DEL LAGO, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 126-57 of the Town Code of Ordinances relating to preservation of historic and specimen trees, procedures are outlined for the designation and de-designation of certain trees as historic or specimen trees; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Palm Beach has undertaken the procedures required to designate certain trees located on properties within the Town as historic or specimen trees; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Palm Beach desires to record said designations in the public records of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to the terms of said Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL of the Town of Palm Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, as follows:
