STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends that Town Council approve Resolution No. 008-2022 authorizing the Town Manager to execute a Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT)

GENERAL INFORMATION

FDOT currently owns the signalized intersections of South County Road at Hammon Road, Worth Avenue, Peruvian Avenue, Royal Palm Way, Barton Avenue, Pinewalk, Breakers, and Royal Poinciana Way to also include Royal Palm Way at Cocoanut Row and Royal Poinciana Way at Cocoanut Row and the Fire Station signal at Ibis Way. The Town has been maintaining these signals without any agreement or reimbursement with FDOT. The Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement, sets forth a mechanism for the Town to be reimbursed annually for maintenance of these intersections. The Town will receive \$50,009 from FDOT at the end of the first year of maintenance less any retainage or forfeiture. Compensation for maintenance for each following year will be adjusted base on the Consumer Price Index. The Agreement also sets forth a process between the Town and FDOT for reimbursement of actual costs incurred to replace or repair signals and devices that have been damaged.

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact to the Town.
