STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff requests that Town Council review the suggested revisions to Town Code of Ordinances, Section 6-636, pertaining to the advisory capacity of the Shore Protection Board.

GENERAL INFORMATION

During the December 14, 2021 regular meeting, Town Council discussed the advisory capacity of the Shore Protection Board.

Consistent with the comments made by Town Council, attached is a red-lined draft of the revisions made by the Town Council. The scope has been adjusted to reflect the Board's refocused duties to include long term planning, public education, and assisting Town staff in applicable communication with the public. Budgeting, lobbying, and intergovernmental coordination are to be stricken as they are responsibilities of the Mayor and Town Council. Finally, other revisions have been suggested by staff because the items are no longer applicable as they were put in place to assist with the creation of the Board.

If no additional direction is provided, Town staff will move forward with ratifying the proposed changes to the Town Code at future Town Council regular meetings.
