

**RESOLUTION NO. 042-2022**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF HISTORIC/SPECIMEN TREE IN THE TOWN'S RIGHTS-OF-WAY AT IBIS ISLE ROAD SOUTH PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 126-57 of the Town Code of Ordinances relating to preservation of historic and specimen trees, procedures and outlined for the designation of certain trees as historic or specimen trees;

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Palm Beach has undertaken the procedures required to designate certain trees located on properties within the Town as historic or specimen trees; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Palm Beach desires to record said designation in the public records of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to the terms of said Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. A Strangler Fig/Golden Fig (botanical name: Ficus Aurea) shall be added as a historic or specimen tree and recorded with the Palm Beach County Clerk:
