As you know, the Town has a "Three Strike Rule" for construction parking and construction site management. The regulations and process are found in the Town's "Department of Public Works, Engineering Division, Standards Applicable to Public Rights-of-Way and Easements Within the Town of Palm Beach" (commonly called the Right-of Way-Manual), dated May 1994, as revised through January 12, 2022. Chapter XII, Miscellaneous Provisions, contains the details of the Three Strike rules. The regulations spell out the process in which contractors can secure parking permits, the fees for various violations, and the process that must occur once a contractor receives Three Strikes – three different sets of tickets for construction violations. The applicable pages of the Right of Way Manual are attached.

1284 N. Lake Way recently reached the level of Three Strikes for construction violations. The first violation (strike) was written for inadequate maintenance of traffic on November 12, 2020 by Public Works. The second violation (strike) was written for construction parking without a permit, on December 21, 2021 by Public Works. Two separate Notice of Violations were issued that day. A Warning Notice was sent to the contractor the same day. The third violation (strike) was written obstruction of the right or way, without a permit, on April 7, 2022 by Code Enforcement. Copies of all violations are attached. The Pending Stop Work Order Notice was sent to the contractor April 8, 2022.

The regulations allow the violator to appeal the ticket(s). In this case, since the last violation was issued by Code Enforcement, the appeal was filed to Police Chief Nick Caristo, by letter dated April 11, 2022. The appeal was filed in accordance with the time allowed under the code (filed within seven (7) days). The regulations required Chief Caristo to hear / review the appeal (if filed) and render a ruling. Chief Caristo found in favor of the Town, and therefore upheld the third violation (Third Strike). This decision occurred on April 12, 2022. The Planning, Zoning & Building Department will issue a STOP WORK ORDER for the entire construction project on April 13, 2022.

The contractor currently owes \$750.00 at this time, for fines and penalties.

The Town Council's process for this matter is contained within the Public Works "Right of Way Manual", as follows:

"When the Town Council receives a written request to lift a stop work order the Town Council shall have the power to admonish the contractor; take such action as deemed necessary to effect the stop work order on a permanent basis by nullifying the existing building permit; cause the contractor and/or property owner to enter into a binding agreement to memorialize the understandings between the Town and the contractor and/or property owner relative to all conditions placed upon the lifting of the stop work order, if applicable; establish penalties for future right-of-way violations the amount for which shall be in the sole discretion of the Town Council; collect the "3 strike" fine, plus payment of any outstanding right-of-way fines and accumulated interest, as referenced herein below and to prohibit the issuance of any additional right-of way permits for the duration of the work in question.

The fine for a third (3rd) and each subsequent strike shall be \$500 plus payment of any outstanding right of-way fines and accumulated interest unless the Town Council chooses to invoke the use of a binding agreement memorializing a penalty structure to be paid to the Town for all future right-of-way violations in excess of three (3) to be paid in accordance with the terms and conditions of the binding agreement between the Town and the contractor and/or property owner. All fines and penalties shall be paid in full prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy for the construction associated with the activity that generated the fines, penalties, and interest."

Any motion to resolve this matter should include "waiving the third strike" and "granting the ability for the contractor to apply for future right of way permits".



Re: Warning Notice Construction Vehicle Parking Citations – 1284 N Lake Way, B-20-85303

On December 21, 2021 you received two citations for violation of the "3-Strike Rule", which regulates the number of construction-related vehicles that can be parked on Town streets in conjunction with building sites. These regulations are contained in the Town of Palm Beach Standards Applicable To Public Rights-Of-Way And Easements Within The Town Of Palm Beach and information regarding these regulations is attached to all construction permits issued to a job site. Specifically, when possible all vehicles should be parked on private property. Permits (up to three in number) can be approved when private parking availability is limited and sufficient spaces in the right-of-way are available.

If three parking citations are received, the Director of Public Works may notify the Planning, Zoning & Building Department of these violations, and request that a "Stop Work" order be issued as allowed by Section 18-204 of Town Code (referred to as the "3-strike" rule).

You have received <u>three</u> parking citations on <u>two</u> separate occasions: December 21, 2021 (PW-5699 for 3 vehicles), December 21, 2021 (PW-5700 for two vehicles) and on November 12, 2020 (PW-5431 for 3 vehicles).

This is to notify you that if you receive another citation, under the Town's rules a "Stop Work" order will be issued by this Department. Please note that if a "Stop Work" order is issued by the Building Official, no work may be performed at the site under any permits issued by the Town of Palm Beach, until the Town Council determines if and under what conditions the work may proceed.

Your cooperation in observing the parking regulations of the Town will assist in ensuring that your job proceeds without disruption.

STOP WORK ORDER PENDING

As you know, the Town of Palm Beach <u>Standards Applicable To Public Rights-Of-Way And Easements Within The Town Of Palm Beach</u> regulates the number of construction-related vehicles that can be parked on Town streets in conjunction with building project sites within the Town and other construction site matters. Attached to all construction permits issued to a job is information regarding these regulations.

This letter is to serve as notice that on three separate occasions you have received citations:

Strike 3 – April 7, 2022 (NOV10245 – Obstruction of the Right of Way without permits

Strike 2 - December 21, 2021 (PW-5699 for 3 vehicles) AND December 21, 2021 (PW-5700 for two vehicles)

Strike 1 - November 12, 2020 (PW-5431 for 3 vehicles)

Per Town Resolution No. 001-2022, because you have received a second and third strike, fines in the amount of \$750.00 are being imposed and are payable immediately to the Town of Palm Beach. This fine is in addition to all right-of-way fines referenced above (PW-6417).

Therefore, under the Town's rules (referred to as the "3-strike" rule), the Chief of Police or the Director of Public Works has notified the Planning, Zoning & Building Department of these violations, and requested that a "Stop Work" order be issued as allowed by Section 18-204 of Town Code.

An appeal to the Chief of Police needs to be submitted in writing within seven (7) calendar days of the date of issuance of the citation. If an appeal is denied or is not filed in a timely fashion, a "Stop Work" order will be issued by the Building Official effective the end of the working day April 14, 2022. After that date, no work may be performed at the site under any permits issued by the Town of Palm Beach.

All requests to lift a "Stop Work" order would need to be decided by the Town Council. The next Town Council meeting date is Tuesday, May 10, 2022. In order for this item to be considered at that meeting, you would need to submit a written request to me no later than Wednesday, May 4, 2022 prior to 5:00 PM.

I am in receipt of your appeal request.

Town Ordinance allows ten days after each violation to contest the violation.

Citation #PW 5431 for construction parking issued on November 11, 2020. Citation #PW 5699 for construction parking issued on December 21, 2020, Citation #PW 5700 for construction parking issued on December 21, 2021. Citation #NOV10245 for construction parking issued on April 7, 2022. Citation #PW 6417 for construction parking issued on April 8, 2022.

Based on the totality of the citations issued, your appeal request is denied.

With the recent changes in Town ordinances and the Town's commitment to strongly enforce construction site violations, I have an obligation to ensure consistencies in the enforcement and appeal process.
