RE: Approve Request by Florida Power & Light (FPL) for Road Closure of Seaview Avenue

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends that Town Council approve the request for Florida Power & Light (FPL) to close Seaview Avenue for two (2) days to complete work at 206 Phipps Plaza.

GENERAL INFORMATION

FPL is requesting a waiver to be able to complete work that will require the closure of Seaview Avenue to install a pole and transformer. The work is needed to move FPL wires to allow safety clearances for the construction on the 206 Phipps Plaza project to be completed.

The work will take place during the weekday with approved dates. This job will take place from 8:30am to 3:30pm on both days. The road will be opened at the end of each day. Property owners that presently park on Seaview Avenue will be notified by FPL of the proposed work and restrictions for parking.

Public Works recommends approval of the waiver request. If approved, Public Works will work directly with FPL to coordinate the necessary right-of-way permit and the appropriate day to complete this work.
